Dhundup Phuntsok is a Tibetan Monk who was born in Tibet in year 1973. He fled from Tibet and arrived to India in 2003. He has no family members here in India except a cousin sister who is also a nun. He lived in Drepung Monastery, South India for 11 years. Later, he moved to Dharamsala in 2012 due to health reasons. He had to go through operation too after reaching here. Currently he is residing in Amdo Village, Mcloedganj in a rented room. He lives with his cousin sister and pays 5000/- per month. At first, he lived in a shabby room where his health was deteriorating as he had an operation. It wasn't good for his health.

The overall treatments and tests took most of his savings and left him with no financial income. Earlier he used to get some money from the religious alms and also his family used to send money from Tibet. Unfortunately, it became difficult after COVID 19. He lost communication with his family in Tibet as We-chat (Social app) was banned in India. We request your kind support in fulfilling his basic necessities.
